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#### STRATEGIC PLAN

#### INFRASTRUCTURE CAPITAL AND ENGINEERING

#### 1. 2024 – 2025:

- A. FlexNet Meters and MXU's Capital Project
- B. Incorporate SI Well into GVWD's potable water system
- C. Review Block 27-S infrastructure plans and oversee any infrastructure construction
- D. Meet with Developer regarding area South of Escondido Wash
- E. Engineering plans for infrastructure expansion south of Escondido Wash (Must meet MDD requirements)
- F. Engineering plans for upgrading Canoa Ranch Booster Station
- G. Install Canoa Ranch Booster Station upgrades

#### 2. **2025 – 2026**:

- A. Complete FlexNet Capital project.
- B. Meet with Freeport Engineers, etc. regarding possible upgrades to Retention Pond that could impact GVWD's Storage tanks.
- C. Evaluate CAP water allocation for retention and/or possible sale
- D. Complete block wall around property located west of Well #1.

#### 3. 2026 -2029:

A. Capital projects and engineering evaluations to be added as identified. (Engineering for all access infrastructure from West Frontage Rd. water line to Canoa Ranch locations to complete "looped system" infrastructure)

#### 4. 2029 - 2934:

- A. Any major capital project over \$1.5mm should be funded via a loan once existing debt has been paid and interest rates are favorable.
- B. Develop capital projects as necessary to ensure GVWD's system meets all ADWR & ADEQ requirements. This includes reliability and capability.
- C. Respond to any further development of Block 36. Additional supply pipeline from infrastructure west of I-19 frontage will be required.
- D. Address pipelines having high number of water leaks. (Slip lining or replacement)
- E. Drill and install B/U well for entire potable water system within Cotonia well site property.
- F. Evaluate possible system expansion as opportunities arise.

## 5. **General comments**:

- A. Vehicle/equipment will be replaced as needed on an annual basis.
- B. GVWD will encourage any replacement of the existing water line from Canoa Rd. to Rest Area must be 12" vs, current 8".
- C. SCADA system additions/upgrades including any antennas will be done as necessary.
- D. GVWD must oversee and inspect any additions/changes to current infrastructure.
